## Rules

- Filmmakers may work individually or in teams
- There is no age restriction to enter the competition
- The films may be of any genre (drama, documentary, comedy, experimental, animation)
- No previously shot footage may be used (up to 20 % archival material may be used)
- Maximum length 4 minutes. (There is no minimum length)
- **No pornographic or inappropriate material will be accepted**
- Entrants will receive a prop requirement that must appear in the film at the start of the challenge.
- 50% discount on YFS/KIAC Equipment for 48 Challenge productions
- Practice the Safe 6 while participating in the Yukon 48 Film Challenge.

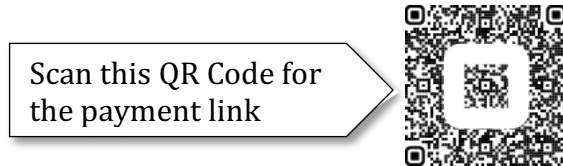
All films must acknowledge the Yukon Film Society (YFS) and the Klondike Institute of Art and Culture (KIAC) in their credits.

The competition starts at **5:30pm on Friday, November 18<sup>th</sup>, 2022**. Participants will be given 48 hours from the time of start to hand in or send a link to download a final **QuickTime/H264 file at 5:30pm on Sunday, November 20<sup>th</sup>, 2022 (No exceptions)**. Please keep your links private until after the screenings on **Nov 23<sup>rd</sup>**.

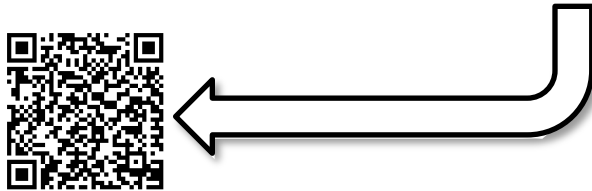
Participants have the option to apply for the **Yukon-Only** challenge and/or the **Canada-Wide** challenge. For the **Yukon-Only** version, **one “key”** that must be used in the film will be revealed at the start of the Challenge. The “key” has to be incorporated into your film in any way (physically, verbally, etc). Participants outside the Whitehorse or Dawson area may participate and can privately upload their film to YouTube or Vimeo or send the links to us. We must have the link by the deadline on Sunday. The **Canada-Wide** competition has the same rules, but with **5 “keys”** to be incorporated in to the film.

Participants must pay an entry fee of \$20 for the **Yukon-Only** and \$25 for the **Canada-Wide** challenges. Youth entries (19 and under) are free. Entry fees can be paid in person at 212 Lambert Street in Whitehorse or online at the following link:

### **Equipment**

Equipment is the responsibility of the entrant, however a 50% discount on YFS and KIAC equipment is available for Yukon 48 Challenge productions for production members in good standing. Equipment should be reserved in advance and is available on a first come first served basis.

\*If booking YFS Equipment from Dawson please book in advance to allow for shipping time. Equipment rental is first come first served.

### **Copyright**

All material used in the films must be owned by the filmmaker. Any copyrighted materials included in the work must have been legally cleared for use. KIAC/YFS are permitted to retain an archive copy of your production for the purposes of promotion for future events. YFS would like to upload the films to our **Available Light On-Demand** platform for streaming and copyrighted material will not be uploaded.

All films will be shown at screenings in Whitehorse and Dawson City on Nov 23<sup>rd</sup>. The screening venue is **Yukon Theatre** for Whitehorse. In Dawson City, at **KIAC Ballroom/Dënäkär Zho**.

Two winning entries, one for Whitehorse and one for Yukon Community based projects, will be decided upon by a jury. The winning entries will receive a **prize of \$500 each** and will be screened at the **2023 Dawson City International Short Film Festival** and the **2023 Available Light Film Festival**. Two Audience Awards will also be presented, voted on by the Whitehorse and Dawson audiences. All submissions (that don't have copyright infringements) will go on the Available Light On-Demand platform for streaming.
